Knowledge about HEM

At the occasion of 7th Anniversary of HEM, the management of HEM conducted interviews addressed to various persons including employees, beneficiaries, government officials, among others to get their knowledge of HEM. A sample of 26 respondents was employed.

The key ideas from the informants revealed that HEM is known as an organisation that helps vulnerable persons (74.8% of respondents). Also, some key informants mentioned HEM as a teaching organisation due to Bible Training (50.1% of respondents). Most of beneficiaries considered HEM as a “parent” (92.3% of respondents-beneficiaries). One of the informant declared “I was an orphan and got a parent”.

Knowledge about HEM services

The informants revealed that services of HEM are known by beneficiaries but also by non-beneficiaries living in the areas of HEM’s operation (82.6% of respondents). Among persons who know the services provided by HEM include SACCOs members, members of women and youth associations working with HEM and many other persons who come to HEM offices in Kampala, Kyaka II Refugee Settlement and Nakivale Refugee Settlement seeking for assistance and unfortunately do not get because of limited financial capability.

What to say about HEM

The interviews conducted wanted to know what interviewees say about HEM? The answers were summarised as follows:

- ✓ We love HEM (66.2% of respondents)
- ✓ We pray for HEM (51.3% of respondents)
- ✓ We admire HEM's projects (61.9% of respondents)
- ✓ HEM provides better services (78.2% of respondents)
- ✓ HEM makes difference from other organisations (49.6% of respondents)
- ✓ May HEM prosper (50.1% of respondents)
- ✓ We want to work or be with HEM, etc. (97.4% of respondents)

As conclusion, the ideas collected using interviews sowed a positive picture of HEM and gave hope for its better future.
