



This marks the first term of the year 2025. We deeply appreciate our generous donors for their continued commitment in supporting and funding HEM's activities. May God bless you abundantly!

During this term, we had the honor of welcoming a guest from Canada, **Mr. Terry MacDonald**, who came to conduct an audit of the funds transferred to HEM from 2022 to February 2025 in support of orphan care. The audit covered **HEM KYAKA II**, **HEM NAKIVALE**, and the **HEM Headquarters in Kampala City**. The process was carried out successfully, and we were pleased to receive a **90% audit score**.

The orphans supported by **BOH** and **HEM** have continued to receive assistance. We give thanks to God for His provision.

Generally, refugees in Uganda are suffering greatly due to hunger and lack of resources. There is no adequate food or financial support. Please note: each refugee receives only 10,000 Ugandan Shillings per month from UNHCR to cover all living expenses, which is far from sufficient to survive.

We are calling on everyone to **advocate for refugees in Uganda**. There is a great need for more donors and supporters.

We continue to pray for the refugees and express our gratitude to **UNHCR** and **OPM** for the little support they are providing.
