3.1.1. Orphans' care

In Kyaka Refugee Settlement, orphans have been lovingly cared for through regular visits that offer emotional support and hope for a brighter future. These children have received vital assistance including payment of school fees, nutritious food, milk, soap for hygiene, and essential school materials such as books, pens, and uniforms. Each visit was not only a moment of practical support but also a time of encouragement and connection. 3.2. REALIZATION IN NAKIVALE REFUGEE SETTLEMENT

HEM has been actively providing care and support to 50 baby orphans in Nakivale Refugee Settlement, ensuring their basic needs are met with love and compassion.

Due to ongoing food shortages and the recent halt of food distribution by UNHCR, the number of orphans in need is expected to rise. In April, May and June, several outreach activities were carried out to support these vulnerable children, including the provision of food, clothing, hygiene supplies, and emotional comfort. The photos below highlight some of the meaningful moments and services extended during that time, reflecting HEM's commitment to protecting and nurturing the most helpless members of the refugee community.



3.3. Evangelism and Church leadership Empowerment

HEM has been actively involved in equipping spiritual leaders in Nakivale Refugee Settlement by training pastors, church leaders, and youth leaders to strengthen the local church and community. Through dedicated teaching and mentorship, HEM helped these leaders grow in biblical knowledge, leadership skills, and ministry effectiveness. A significant milestone was reached when 23 pastors and church leaders successfully graduated from the ISOM (International School of Ministry) curriculum, marking a powerful step forward in their spiritual and leadership journeys. 
